h. In making this Award, it shall be understood that the COOPeration Committee is acting for square and round dancers in EDSARDA, callers in NECCA, and round dance teachers in NECORTA.

RED DOT DANCER

> The idea behind the "red dot dancer" is to enable aingle dancera ease in finding o dance parther, In years past, our single dancers might have had an area to gather or a get acguainted gathering to meet and find partners. Today, some aggressive solos will maintain a spot in a square unsil another individual steps up to dance with them. To give all single doncers equal opportunity to enjoy the activity. the "red dot dancer" concept was conceived. Upon antering a dance, a dancer may wish to display aticky (easily removable) red dot on their badge or ribbon. This red dot indicates that you are: 1) a solo dancer lone who daes not have a parther OR 2) a doncer who is willing to dance with others for certein tips during the event. It o person's partner doean't wish or isn't able to donce every tip due to health or other issues, o red dot would show their avalability to dance solo.

An additional feature may be odded (a star within the red dot) which indicates the ability of the "red dot" wearer to dance either left or right side of the portnership.
